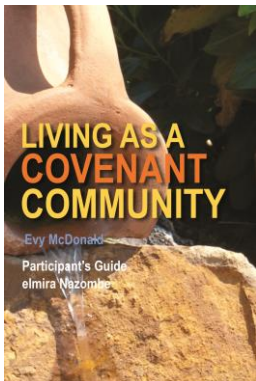

SPIRITUAL GROWTH STUDY: *Living as a Covenant Community*

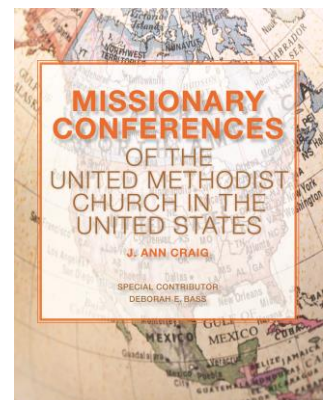
